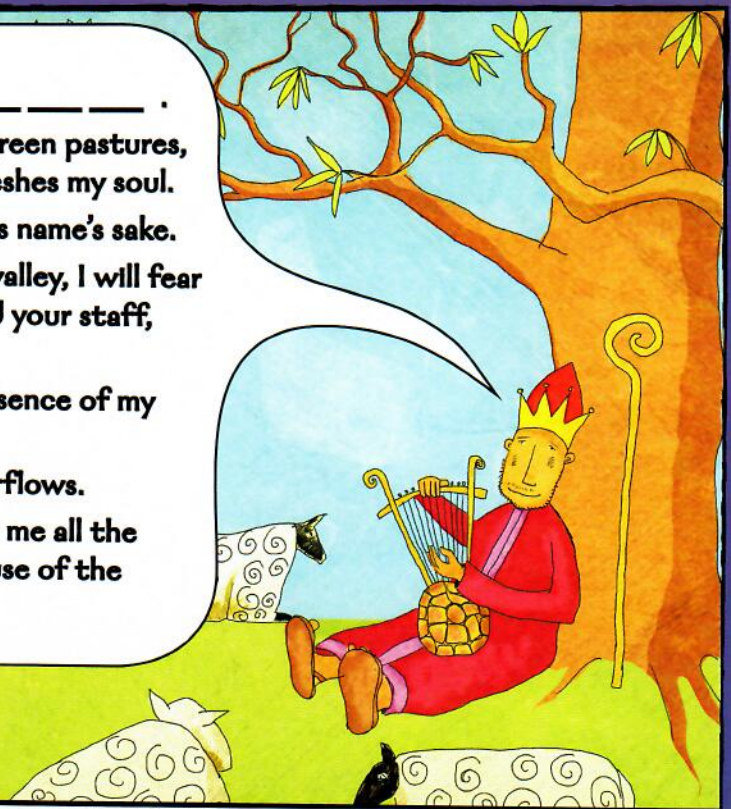


**The Good Shepherd** (David the shepherd king, from Psalm 51; 2 Samuel 7; paraphrase of Psalm 23)

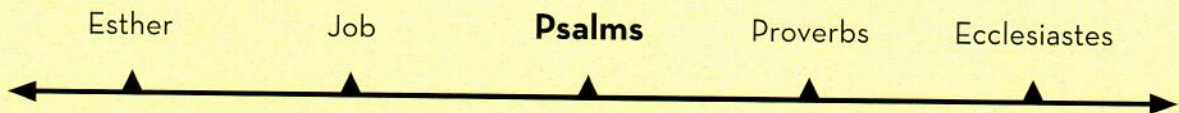
